# CVSR-01 Compressor Vibration Sound Reduction Kit

## Description

This kit contains the following components.

B520078 - Compressor terminal cover.

B1488819 - Compressor sound blanket.

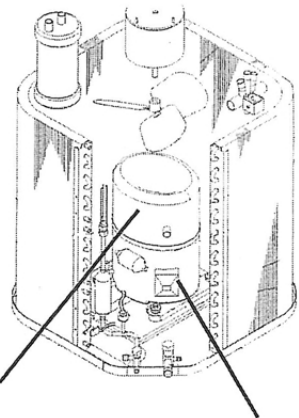

## WARNING

To avoid death, personal injury or property damage due to electrical shock, disconnect the electrical power supply before servicing this unit. Some models will have two power sources be certain to disconnect both power sources. This may include the indoor unit as well as the outdoor unit.

5. Inspect compressor wires to insure they were not disturbed.
6. Install the compressor sound blanket B1488819 onto compressor.
7. Ensure the blanket is not interfering with wires or other components.
8. Close the access door or the top, whichever you used to access the unit. Tighten all screws.
9. Turn power ON.
10. Verify unit will operate properly.

## Installation Procedures

1. Disconnect Power Supply.
2. For ease of installation, remove either the access door or top of the condenser carefully.
3. Remove compressor terminal cover (plastic cap) without unplugging any wires.
4. Install new compressor terminal cover B520078.
